The Need for High Quality Adult Education

In Colorado, over 300,000 adults do not have a high school credential, with 41 percent of those individuals having less than a 9th grade level of education. Of these individuals, 24 percent of them live below the poverty line. 74 percent of all jobs statewide will require some level of post-secondary education or training by the year 2020, well exceeding the national average.
